The St. Louis City Circuit Court converted to E-filing on July 8, 2013.

The new deposit amounts to secure court costs (filing fees) for the 22nd Judicial

Circuit, as modified beginning January 1, 2015, shall be as follows:


Associate Civil Cases	\$93.00
Sheriff's service fee for each Defendant to be served by the City Sheriff	36.00
Circuit Civil Cases	145.00
Sheriff's service fee for each Defendant to be served by the City Sheriff	36.00
Family Court Matters	177.00
Sheriff's service fee for Respondent To be served by City Sheriff	36.00
Small Claims Cases (under \$5,000)	80.00
Sheriff's service fee for each City defendant	36.00
Certified Mail service fee for each defendant	10.04
Expungements	245.00
Trials de Novo	45.00
Appeals	70.00
Garnishments	10.00

When paying filing fees for any particular case, the attorney should include an amount for service only when that attorney is requesting service by the St. Louis City Sheriff's Office. Payment for the cost of service by the sheriff of any other county or by a private process server should be made directly to the server of process and should not be included in the costs deposit paid to the St. Louis City Circuit Clerk.

These filing fees shall be posted on the Court's web site (www.stlcitycircuitcourt.com) pursuant to Local Rule 5.1.
