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## What is Family Sub-Contracted Services?

Family Sub-Contracted Services (FSCS) is a program of sub-contracted services provided to the clients of the Family Court. The services consist of:

- Individual and Family Counseling
- Occupational Therapy
- Bullying Prevention
- Tutoring
- Respite care
- Psychological evaluations
- Sex offender evaluations
- Sex offender specific treatment
- Life Skills Groups
- Parenting Skills
- Co-parenting Skills
- Educational groups for children of separated/divorced parents
- Anger Management
- Mentoring

## Who is Eligible for Services?

All clients of the Family Court

whose case has been opened and is classified by appropriate Family Court personnel as an active case or City Court clients shall be eligible for counseling, casework services, and/or any and all other services.

The services are voluntary in informal cases and required when included in the Court Order.

Please note: The contractual agency/vendor shall reserve the right to accept or reject the referral.

### Referrals:

#### Who can make them?

Family Sub-Contracted Services referrals can be generated from any Family Court Deputy Juvenile Officer.

#### Who monitors the cases?

While a family and/or juvenile is receiving Family Sub-Contracted Services, the Deputy Juvenile Of-

ficer assigned will maintain contact with the family as well as the agency/vendor in order to monitor and support services provided.

Progress reports are provided to the Deputy Juvenile Officer by the contracted agency/vendor.

The Family Sub-Contracted Services Program Liaison coordinates and supports a positive working relationship between vendors and the Family Court.
